

NATIONAL POWERS


- Maintain military

SHARED POWERS

- Collect taxes
- Establish courts
- Regulate interstate commerce

- Provide for the general welfare
- Punish criminals

STATE POWERS

- Establish local governments
- Set up schools
- Regulate state commerce
- Make regulations for marriage
- Establish and regulate corporations
