


Parent polling shows overwhelming support for protecting sensitive locations

Parents draw a bright line around immigration enforcement in schools


New nationwide polling of parents shows overwhelming bipartisan support for keeping immigration enforcement away from children’s daily lives, especially their schools. **75% of parents – including 59% of GOP parents – are concerned that increased ICE operations would disrupt their children’s education.**
